REPORT TO ANNUAL PARISH MEETING 2021

This report in some ways is difficult to write because there is little to report!

We still remain a small, but faithful congregation who, pre-covid had services in our own chapel at least 3 times a month. Since the first lockdown we have had just 3 services in the chapel: October, Christmas and Easter Day – it was important to us that we were able to worship together to celebrate the joy of Easter. We plan to have another service in May, and then see how the Roadmap is going before the Methodist Church in Shropshire decides on when regular services can recommence. Because of social distancing, etc., we have not advertised these services, but please know we do remember all our friends with whom we are not able to meet.

We arranged a fund-raiser for last spring – the visit of the Newtown Male Voice Choir, which we postponed in view of the (then) approaching coronavirus. For those of you who were looking forward to hearing the choir, the concert will be re-arranged, but at the moment we do not have a date.

So we look forward, with hope, to a year in which we begin to be able to connect with people once again.
