- b) Shropshire Council Cllr Charmley reported that 'Fix My Street' (an application to report issues such as potholes to Shropshire Council) was now live and fully integrated with the Shropshire Council website. He also reported that he had been contacted by a couple of residents who were very upset about the planning application at item 22.22(a)(ii) and he had directed them to submit comments on the planning portal. Cllr Hesketh reported her concerns to Cllr Charmley that the road at Rednal down to the industrial estate was again suffering badly with potholes, and the 'Queens Head' name plate on entering Queens Head from the Rednal Straight was still broken despite having been reported a couple of years ago.

The Clerk also updated Members on communications from Shropshire Council in which they had advised that it was not possible to amend the s106 Alma Close agreement to release the monies to the council for play equipment at the playing field. The Clerk advised that she will press Shropshire Council as to what they intend to do with the money, and Cllr Charmley was also asked if he could intervene in this matter.

- b) WI tree the WI's proposed location for the tree to be planted at the playing field (ref item 116.21(b)) was considered and was agreed in principle subject to seeing a plan of exactly where it was going and subject to it being a native species. It was NOTED in the Clerk's report that written permission obtained by the WI from the landlord's agent had been received by the Clerk.

24.22 PARISH MATTERS

- a) Conservation Area Shropshire Council's amendments to the boundary of the proposed Conservation Area were considered. It was RESOLVED to accept the revised boundary in principle, subject to any minor amendments agreed by Shropshire Council at a site visit with the parish council Chairman and conservation consultant. It was FURTHER RESOLVED to delegate power to the Clerk to agree to any such amendments to the boundary on behalf of the parish council.
- b) CIL monies suggestions for spending of CIL monies, including those made at the Annual Parish Meeting 2022 were considered. It was RESOLVED to set up a Task & Finish Group consisting of Cllrs Hesketh, Mabe, Houghton, Grove and Thornhill to consider and prioritise all suggestions and then report back to full council.
- c) Sandstone wall on Holyhead Road reported damage to the wall (on the left when entering the village from Queens Head) was considered. It was agreed that this should be raised with Shropshire Council at the Conservation Area site visit (ref item 24.22(a)) with a follow up from the Clerk.

Three applications for co-option were considered. A vote was taken, and Ozcan Ozagir and Chris Jones were co-opted onto the council. The Chairman commented that the quality of all applications was high and asked the Clerk to thank all applicants for applying.
