	A member of the public advised that he was a resident of Grimpo and was speaking on behalf of other Grimpo residents as well. He informed members that the Woodhouse estate had served notice on a			
	number of tenants due to plans to sell some of the land and cottages. There was concern among			
	residents that this would be bought by developers for housing which would have a detrimental affect			
	on villagers. He wished to make members aware of this. The second member of the public reiterated			
	these concerns.			
	Cllr Walker thanked the members of the public for making the council aware of this. He advised that			
	under the existing local plan Grimpo is classed as open countryside and so cannot be built on. Under			
	the emerging local plan the village would become a community hub. Development could only get permission outside the development boundary, as an exception site, if the site touches the			
	development boundary around the village and does not apply to the hamlets.			
	The members of the public left the meeting at the end of this item.
